Explore Program

Continuing education at Central Piedmont provides advanced and inservice training for all public safety professions. Offerings include the college's American Academy of Applied Forensics (AAAF) training for law enforcement as well as Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) and Paramedic training.

The program includes training for law enforcement and Fire and Rescue municipal and volunteer agencies. Public safety continuing education courses are typically offered at the Claudia Watkins Belk Center for Justice on the <u>Merancas Campus</u>.
